HYBRID GIGS:

For all our friends who cannot make it to Clonakilty this year, we will be broadcasting live-streamed shows w/ audiences and recorded concerts on the internet. You can follow the fun in real time via YouTube and if you miss that you can catch-up on our social media channels. But don't forget...the Stream will self-destruct after 48 hrs.

GUITARTOWN CINEMA:

2021 will also see the arrival of Guitartown's first outdoor cinema, transforming Emmet Square briefly and safely into a theatre of dreams. We'll be premiering performances specially filmed for CIGF21 at iconic locations throughout our town.

Among some of the performances included are: excerpts from Scoil na mBuachaillí's Scoilavision 21, a series of curated performances from Shanley's famous piano bar and the world premiere of a new concert film recorded in Clonakilty by Ireland's top music documentarian, Myles O'Reilly.

REVERB:

We want the impact of our festival to continue to reverberate throughout the town, so we are partnering with The Irish Wheelchair Association, Cope Foundation, Clonakilty Community Hospital, Scoil na mBuachaillí, Clonakilty Friends of Asylum Seekers and more for a series of concerts and private cinema screenings across the week, some of which will be open to the public.

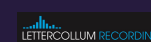
